- Display foods from around the world
- Display a world map or globe
 - Sing a song about creation

- Genesis 1 God created the heavens and the earth
- Isaiah 55: 6-13: Provoding seed for the sower and bread for the eating.
- Psalm 103 Send forth your Spirit, O Lord
- 2 Cor 9:8-11: He will make the harvest of your good deeds a larger one.
- Matthew 13:1-9: Parable of the Sower

Symbolic Action

- Bring forward something from creation
- Pray for the people who produce our food
- Pray for those who go without
- Make a connection between creation and our talents

Send Forth

- Make a commitment to do something for the environment
- Begin a fund-raising project
- Make a connection with the Fruits of the Holy Spirit
